Nick Vujicic was born without arms and legs but two small feet, one of which had two toes. Due to his physical disability, he was bullied by his friends and he fell into a severe depression. He even thought of drowning himself in the bathtub at the age of 10. However, with the support from his parents, he started to adapt and lived a full life without limbs.

After a long struggle, Nick Vujicic is able to write with his two toes on his left foot. He is also able to use computer, to play drum pedals, to comb his hair, to brush his teeth and to answer the phone. He even joins the golf, swimming and diving courses.

In 2005, Nick Vujicic was nominated for the Young Australian of the Year Award. Today, his books and speeches have inspired others to be grateful of their life.

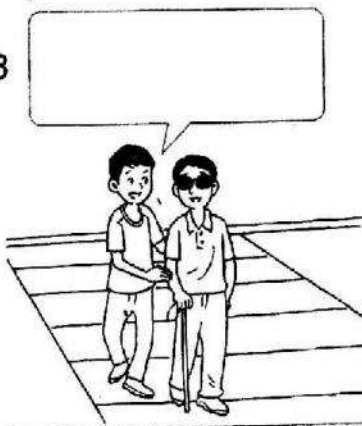

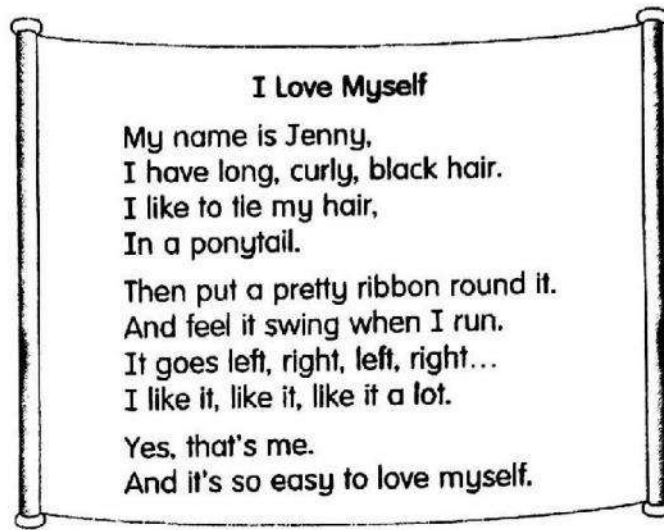
